#### This funding will be used to

Achieve continued measurable improvement in **Reading**, **Writing** and **Mathematics** across all year levels: -

- A further increase in the percentage of students, in all year levels achieving A/B in Reading,
   Writing and Mathematics A-E data and decrease in students achieving D/E in Reading, Writing and Mathematics A-E data (as detailed in Annual Improvement Plan)
- A further increase in the percentage of students in the Upper 2 Bands in Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN in Reading, Writing (focus for Year 5) and Numeracy (focus for both Year 3 and 5)
- A further increase in the percentage of students above the National Minimum Standard in Numeracy in Year 5 and maintain no student being below the NMS in Reading, Writing and Numeracy in Year 3

Further develop teachers' capacity to collaboratively plan and deliver all areas of the Australian Curriculum with an emphasis on cross-curriculum priorities and general capabilities with a **focus on critical and creative thinking:** -

- All teachers planning and delivering all areas of the Australian Curriculum collaboratively in year level teams.
- All teachers using evidence to tailor differentiated Literacy and Numeracy lessons to meet the learning needs of every student Prep to Year 6

#### Our initiatives include

Continued implementation of **Robina SS Whole School Agreed Practices** in the teaching of English and Mathematics using analysis of individual student data to deliver differentiated English and Mathematics lessons focussing on:

- knowing where every student is in their progression of learning
- providing clear and precise information to each student to ensure they know what they are going to learn and where they are heading
- providing each student with precise feedback about where to next to move students' learning forward

Peer Mentoring of teachers to collaboratively plan and deliver differentiated instruction in the teaching of English and Mathematics:

- Continue to strengthen teachers' capacity to analyse individual student data to inform their teaching and differentiate their delivery of English and Mathematics lessons to meet specific student learning needs
- Continue to strengthen teachers' capacity in the teaching of English and Mathematics focussing on the general capabilities with a particular emphasis on critical and creative thinking
